BRST - paclitaxel (protein bound) weekly

ARIA: BRST - [paclitaxel (protein bound) weekly]

Planned Course: Days 1, 8 and 15 until disease progression or unacceptable toxicity

(1 cycle = 28 days)

Indication for Use: Breast Cancer

CVAD: At Provider's Discretion

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than $1.5 \times 10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than $100 \times 10^9/L$

Contact Physician if parameters not met
