ARIA: BRST - [gemcitabine + PACLitaxel]

Planned Course: Every 21 days until disease progression or unacceptable toxicity

Indication for Use: Breast Cancer Metastatic or Recurrent

CVAD: At Provider's Discretion

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 x $10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than $100 \times 10^9/L$

Contact Physician if parameters not met
