Indication for Use: Gastric Cancer; Adjuvant

CVAD: At Provider's Discretion

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 x 10⁹/L AND Platelets equal to or greater than 100 x 10⁹/L ↔ Contact Physician if parameters not met
