Planned Course: Every 28 Days for 6 cycles<br>Indication for Use: Urothelial Carcinoma

CVAD: At provider's discretion

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Proceed with treatment if:
ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 < 109/L AND Platelets equal to or greater than 100 x 109/L
    & Contact Physician if parameters not met

## Treatment Regimen - GENU - gemcitabine

Establish primary solution 500 mL of: normal saline

| Drug | Dose | CCMB Administration Guideline |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Days $\mathbf{1 , 8}$ and $\mathbf{1 5}$ |  |  |
| dexamethasone | 8 mg | Orally 30 minutes pre-chemotherapy |
| gemcitabine | $1250 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{m}^{2}$ | IV in normal saline 250 mL over 30 minutes |

In the event of an infusion-related hypersensitivity reaction, refer to the 'Hypersensitivity Reaction Standing Order'

## REQUIRED MONITORING

All Cycles

- CBC, serum creatinine, liver enzymes and electrolytes as per Physician Orders

| Recommended Support Medications |  |  |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Drug | Dose | CCMB Administration Guideline |
| metoclopramide | $10-20 \mathrm{mg}$ | Orally every 4 hours as needed for nausea and vomiting |

## DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

- Instruct patient to continue taking anti-emetic(s) at home
- Reinforce applicable safe handling precautions of medications, blood and body fluids for 48 hours after completion of chemotherapy
