Regimen Reference Order – GENU – olaparib

ARIA: GENU - [olaparib]

Planned Course:Twice daily until disease progression or unacceptable toxicity
(1 cycle = 30 days)Indication for Use:BRCA or ATM Mutated Castration-Resistant Prostate Cancer

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 x 10⁹/L AND Platelets equal to or greater than 100 x 10⁹/L Contact Physician if parameters not met

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENT

- Instruct patient to continue taking anti-emetic(s) at home
- olaparib has potential for drug-drug interactions. Patients should notify clinic prior to starting any new medication
- Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice, Seville oranges (i.e. orange marmalade) and starfruit
- Reinforce applicable safe handling precautions of medications, blood and body fluids while on olaparib

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- olaparib can rarely cause pneumonitis
- secondary malignancy (MDS/AML) has been reported with olaparib (rare). Monitor for prolonged cytopenia
- LHRH analog treatment (i.e. leuprolide or goserelin) or LHRH antagonist (degarelix) is continued during olaparib treatment
- olaparib will be dispensed by CCMB Pharmacy
