Regimen Reference Order – gemcitabine

ARIA: GYNE - [gemcitabine]

Planned Course: Every 28 days until disease progression or unacceptable toxicity

Indication for Use: Ovarian Cancer Recurrent

CVAD: At Provider's Discretion

Proceed with treatment if:

Cycle 1, Day 1

ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 x $10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than $100 \times 10^9/L$

Cycle 1, Day 8 and onwards

ANC equal to or greater than 1.2 x $10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than 75 x $10^9/L$

Contact Physician if parameters not met
