

## Regimen Reference Order – SUPP – inFLIXimab

ARIA: SUPP – [inFLIXimab]

**Planned Course:** Number of doses to be determined based on patient response

**Indication for Use:** Grade 3 or 4 toxicities from Immune Checkpoint Inhibitors

**CVAD:** At Provider’s Discretion

**Blood work at provider’s discretion: not required to proceed with treatment**

### SEQUENCE OF MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION

**Treatment Regimen – SUPP – inFLIXimab**

**Establish primary solution 500 mL of: normal saline**

Drug	Dose	CCMB Administration Guideline
inFLIXimab (brand name specific)	5 mg/kg	IV in 250 mL normal saline following administration rates below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>30 mL/hour for 15 minutes, then</li> <li>60 mL/hour for 30 minutes, then</li> <li>125 mL/hour to complete the infusion</li> </ul> Use 0.2 or 0.22 micron filter Concentration dependent drug: Pharmacy will adjust diluent volume to ensure drug stability *Alert: Pharmacy to ensure final volume in bag = 250 mL *Nursing Alert: IV tubing is primed with inFLIXimab *Alert: Ensure brand name on prescription label (indicated in brackets on prescription label) matches prescribed order

All doses will be automatically rounded that fall within the DSG Approved Dose Bands. See SUPP DSG – Dose Banding document for more information

**In the event of an infusion-related hypersensitivity reaction, refer to the ‘Hypersensitivity Reaction Standing Order’**

### REQUIRED MONITORING

All doses

- Monitor blood pressure, heart rate and temperature prior to infusion, every 30 minutes during infusion, 30 minutes after the infusion and 1 hour after the infusion
- Blood work as per Physician Orders

**DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS**

- Patients should be instructed to contact their cancer team immediately if symptoms of hypersensitivity reactions occur after discharge
