ARIA: LUNG - [vinorelbine (MPM)]

Planned Course: Once weekly until progression or unacceptable toxicity (1 cycle = 42 days)

Indication for Use: Malignant Pleural Mesothelioma

CVAD: Preferred (VESICANT INVOLVED)

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than $1.5 \times 10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than $100 \times 10^9/L$

Contact Physician if parameters not met
