Head Huggers: Crochet Pattern:

J.T.'s Favorite Stitch Chemo Cap

Crochet Head Hugger Designed by: Christine Marie Way Tyler & John Wesley Tyler

Vary the size of the crochet hook and the thickness (type) of yarn to vary

Round 1: SC, DC, *SC, DC.* Repeat pattern from * to * to the end of the round (for 12 stitches). Chain 5 - sl st to connect - chain 1

Work in rounds marking the first st of each round

Round 2: SC and DC in each st of the previous round,

Round 3: SC, *DC and SC in next st, DC in next st, SC and DC in next st,

Repeat pattern from * to * to the end of the round

Round 4: SC, *DC in next st, SC and DC in next st, SC in next st* Repeat pattern from * to * to the end of the round To make cap larger, repeat Round 4 and/or add more rounds to section of Rounds 5-14.

Repeat pattern from * to * to end of Round 14.

(ALWAYS do SC in DC of previous round and do DC in SC of Rounds 5-14: SC, *DC in next st, SC in next st* previous round!!)

Round 15: SC around and finish off.

Alternate Round 15: *chain 3, SC in next st, chain 3, SC in next st,* Repeat pattern from * to * and finish off.
